### **ACTIVITIES IN SCHOOL**




The small group of children in school have continued to work hard and show enthusiasm in very challenging circumstances.

#### FREE SCHOOL MEALS

The Government scheme to provide food vouchers for those children entitled to free school meals is now up and running, through their partner, Edenred.

Eligible families should now have received an email with their voucher code for the first month. Brentside are aiming to send codes out monthly, rather than weekly, in order to reduce the time you will have to spend logging in. We are aware that some people are continuing to have problems with the system, and we are doing our best to solve these, but Edenred are experiencing a great deal of demand and technical difficulties.

If you have not applied for free schools meals but think you may be eligible, please email the school office. FAQs about the scheme are available on the school website.
