



# Nursery- Work in case of a forced school closure



On this sheet you will find a series of tasks and activities relating to each area of the curriculum. The activities are designed to be used in case we need to close the school for any reason beyond our control. You can complete these activities when you want and how you want over the time that you are off school. Each activity or task is related to your year group, designed to be open ended, and can all be done at home with minimal resources.

## ENGLISH

- Practice writing your name
- Read your school book and talk about the pictures
- Read your library book and talk about the pictures
- Practice pencil control sheets (type into Google 'pencil control sheets')
- Draw a picture and write a diary each day of what you are doing
- Adult to write different sounds on the middle of a A4 paper and children cut and stick things that begin with that letter, e.g. A=Apple, Ant etc.
- Practice writing letters correctly (type into Google 'letter formation sheets')

## MATHS

- Practice counting to 5 and then to 10
- Practice writing numbers to 5 and then to 10
- Match the right amount of objects to the right number to 10, e.g 5 pencils next to the number 5
- Sort different objects in your house by colour, by weight, by length
- Create different coloured patterns with objects in your house
- Go on a shape hunt around your house and look at the different shapes within your house

## ART

- Draw a picture of a favourite toy
- Draw a picture of your family
- Draw a picture of any pets you might have
- Make a collage of a minibeast
- Draw your favourite story book character

## RE

Draw a picture of all the religious festivals you celebrate and talk to your parent or carer about them.

## HISTORY

Draw a picture of you as a baby and of you now, and talk to an adult about what is the same and what is different about you.

## PE

- Go onto Youtube, type in 'Cosmic Yoga', and copy the Cosmic Yoga teacher
- Go onto Youtube, type in 'Five a Day Fitness' and copy the sport exercises or the Jubilee dances
- Dance to different types of music

## COMPUTERS

- Play games on Cbeebies
- Draw a picture on paint
- Take pictures on an iPad of what you are doing each day

## GEOGRAPHY

- Draw a picture of your house and talk about where you live
- Talk about if any relatives live in a different country & discuss what is the same and what is different

## MUSIC

- Make some musical instruments using pasta, rice, lentils and plastic cups
- Make music using your body
- Dance to different types of music and move in different ways

## PSHE

- Draw a picture of who your friend is and talk about why they are your friend
- Talk to an adult about how to be a good friend and what it means to be a good friend
- Talk about different feelings and when you would have those feelings
