Music Activity: Rhyme Time

ICT Activity: Purple Mash

Art Activity: Craft Time!

Maths Activity: Sharing

Introduce sharing to your child by getting various objects (e.g. sweets, toys etc.) and handing the objects out equally between you and your child. Get your child to record sharing on the sheet provided. Your child can draw the objects that they are sharing or write the number on the sheet. Go over sharing again on another day.

Literacy Activity: Story Writing

Help your child become an author by writing their own story! They need to think of characters and a simple plot, e.g. finding a magical object, getting ready for a party etc. In order for your child to make a super story they need to remember; capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Get your child to write a bit each day and once finished your child can draw pictures to illustrate their story.
