Maths activity: Estimating

Introduce estimating to your child by getting various objects from around the house and while handing the objects to your child, ask 'How many do you think there are?' Get your child to guess how many while holding them and then count the objects. Complete estimating worksheet.

Music activity: Rhyme Time

- Get your child to practice and perform the rhyme "Jack and Jill went up the hill"
- Think about and use the sounds of daily life Together with your child you could explore the sounds heard on different journeys.

For example:

- What does the journey to the park sound like – what may we hear on the way?
- A journey around a supermarket will involve a range of different sounds.

You could make a piece of music together that represents different types of journeys that you make.

Literacy activity: Write a letter.

Write a letter to your friend to tell them what you have been doing while we haven't been in school. Remind your child to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
