### Part 1:

### Part 2:

Decide on a book that you are going to create. You will need to think about whether a topic and what you will need to use to make your book.

### Part 3:

Make your book. Use any resources that you have around your home or you can use a computer. Think carefully about what you need in your book: does it have pictures, contents, index and a glossary.
