



## Year 2- Work in case of a forced school closure



On this sheet you will find a series of tasks and activities relating to each area of the curriculum. The activities are designed to be used in case we need to close the school for any reason beyond our control. You can complete these activities when you want and how you want over the time that you are off school. Each activity or task is related to your year group, is designed to be open ended, and can all be done at home with minimal resources.

### ENGLISH

- Define a contraction.
- Write at least 10 sentences including contractions.
- Continue working on your English SATs buster.
- Write sentences using the Year 2 Common exception words.
- Practise phase 5 and 6 phonics using Phonics Play and YouTube. You can also use Monster Phonics – the login for this is on our school website.
- Write a story creating a new adventure for Paddington. Remember to include a beginning, middle and end to your story and use adjectives to describe your characters!
- Write a recount of the story 'Mr. Majeika.' What was the story about? Can you remember any key moments in the story?

### MATHS

- Work on the Year 2 Maths SATs buster.
- Continue to practise the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables
- Continue to practise your division facts using these times tables
- Choose fifteen numbers and identify the hundreds, tens and thousands in those numbers.
- Use a measuring jug and measure 20ml, 50 ml and 1l. Can you use this to help with cooking at home?
- Can you write word problems for your siblings or parents involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division?
- Identify the odd and even numbers up to 250.
- Continue working on your Maths SATs Buster.

### ART

- Research the artist Wassily Kandinsky.
- Recreate one of his paintings.

### DT

- List the materials needed to create salt dough.
- Create an object using salt dough.

### SCIENCE

- Can you name the organs in the human body. What do each of them do?
- Can you name and research 5 plants?
- Research the planets that make up our solar system. Is there a rhyme to help you remember them?

### RE

- Create a poster to explain why we celebrate Easter.
- Write about the Easter story.

### PE

- Take part in Joe Wicks PE lessons
- Can you accurately dribble a football?
- Can you do 20 frog jumps and 15 push ups?
- Play an active game with the members of your family, can you change any of the rules slightly?

### COMPUTERS

- Activities will have been set on Purple Mash.
- Can you improve the speed that you type?
- Can you create a drawing digitally?

### GEOGRAPHY

What are the 7 continents?

Choose one continent to share 10 facts about.

Find out:

- What the climate is like
- What countries are in that continent
- Species of animals found there
- Traditions and cultures

### HISTORY

- Research the Stone Age. Find out the dates, key people, key innovations and what life was like before and after the stone age. Create a presentation on purple mash to share with your family.

### MUSIC

- Clap the rhythm of your favourite song.
- How many beats are there in a crotchet, quaver and minim?
