Let's write a haiku poem. Haiku is a type of poem which comes from Japan. It's layout is as follows: 1<sup>ST</sup> line has 5 syllables, for example: My little brother

2<sup>nd</sup> line has 7 syllables, for example: Comes crashing into my room.

3<sup>rd</sup> line has 5 syllable, for example: He always breaks stuff

Haiku poems do not have to rhyme.

- -Think of a topic or object. Plan.
- -List some adjectives about your topic/objects
- Write some interesting facts about your topic/objects
- -Draw a picture about your topic/objects

Now choose the best words for your haiku poem and write it out.

Remember:

 $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  line 5 syllables ,  $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$  line 7 syllables ,  $\mathbf{3}^{\text{rd}}$  line 5 syllables.HAVE FUN!
