Estimating time

Extension: Write down the time you started and without looking at the clock, work out and write the current time it should be after having completed your activity.

PE - Dance!

Choreograph your own dance to perform to your class when we get back to school!

MUSIC - Compose a rhythm (Ctd)

Write down symbols to represent different sounds you can make using items in your home(E.g 'h' for tapping a hairbrush)Can you create a simple rhythm and write it down?
