ENGLISH

- Read 7 non-fiction books
- Read 7 fiction books

- Practice spellings from your Year 4 spellings list
- Complete a book review

MATHS

- Times tables practice using Purple Mash
- Find lines of symmetry in items around your house
- Plot co-ordinates on a graph to produce a 2D shape
- Practice switching times from the 12 hour clock to the 24 hour clock

DT

Cooking- Seasonal foods

- Research which fruit and vegetables are in season at the moment.
- Can you create a recipe and make the dish?

ART

Developing sketching:

- Practice sketching faces
- Focus on adding details

SCIENCE

This year in Science we have learnt about sound, states of matter, teeth and electricity. Can you create a poster discussing these topics.

RE

- Research stories told by Jesus
- Prepare a presentation you could share with the class on a story Jesus told to his followers

PE

HIIT- Using the exercises we have been practicing at morning play, design an exercise programme to share with your family. It should include 5 exercises for 1 minute each.

COMPUTERS

It is extremely important to be able to use the internet effectively. Using Purple Mash, explore the unit **(4.7)** on effective searching.

GEOGRAPHY

Research the countries that make up the European Union. What is the European Union? How many countries are there? What are the capital cities of these countries?

HISTORY

Why were Norman castles certainly not bouncy? Explore and create a fact file.

MUSIC

Think about your favourite song. Find the lyrics online and explore their meaning. How does this song make you feel?

PSHE

This term we are looking at charity. Can you plan an event to raise money for charity? Research a charity you would like the proceeds to go to. Why have you chosen this charity?
