Each activity or task are related to your year group and designed to be open ended and can all be done at home with minimal resources.

ENGLISH

- Watch a TV programme with no sound and subtitles on. How difficult is it to follow? Write a description of your experience.
- Recreate one of the scenes from one of your favourite shows. Write your own dialogue for this scene.
- Make your own revision guide for all the grammar rules you know of.
- Copy a paragraph from one of your reading books in your best handwriting.
- Choose ten spellings from your reading book that you do not know how to spell, practice and learn.
- Challenge – What is the hardest word you can learn to spell?

MATHS

- Continue to learn all times tables using the site 'Hit the button' to help. Also work on number bonds, halves, doubles and square numbers on the same site.
- Complete all tasks on Purple Mash.
- Create your own multi-step word problems. Challenge a friend.
- Create a poster showing your understanding of angles.
- Work out what 50%, 25%, 10% of 10 different numbers.
- Challenge – Can you find 5%, 15% of these amounts?

ART

Create your own collage of all your favourite things using magazines and newspapers.

DT

Create a model aeroplane, think about how you can improve your design to make it glide or travel the furthest distance for as long as possible.

SCIENCE

Carry out your own experiments to investigate how temperature changes. How do we keep things warm or cool?

RE

Research the different the different religious buildings in your local area.

PE

Create your own dance routine to one of your favourite songs.

COMPUTERS

Choose some software (Word, Publisher, Powerpoint) to create a presentation on a subject of your own choice.

GEOGRAPHY

Find and locate the seven continents on the planet and learn where they are.

HISTORY

Create your own presentation on The Gun Powder Plot.

MUSIC

Find similarities between two or more of your favourite composers.

PSHE

Create a poster on the British Values – Mutual respect and tolerance, The rule of law, democracy and individual liberty.
