On this sheet you will find a series of tasks and activities relating to each area of the curriculum. - Have a go at as many activities as you can. Write a list of the ones that you complete.
- Make a list of as many powerful adjectives as you can. Use 5 in your own well-punctuated sentences.

- Continue learning all tables and division facts on 'Hit the button' if you don't know them already.
- On Purple mash, complete all tasks set.
- Can you find 20 different ways of making 478?
- Find the website <https://nrich.maths.org/14583>. Have a go at as many activities as you can. Take notes of everything you've done.
- Ask each member of your household for a number they choose. Write them down and make an add, subtract, times and divide calculation.
- Count the number of biscuits in a packet. Work out as many different fractions of that amount as you can.

### ART

- Produce a piece of Art inspired by what you see.
- Create a portrait of someone.

### COMPUTERS

- Produce an information sheet on your favourite hobbies at home.

- Design your own invention. It can be for any use or purpose. If you can, try to make it using recycled materials.

### GEOGRAPHY

- Find out about Amazon rainforest tribes.
- Find out about what they eat, where they live, their houses, beliefs, how we are affecting their lives and anything else that interests you.

- Make a factfile about planets in our solar system.

- Write an explanation of each object.
