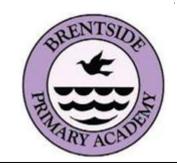

Maths- Complete worksheet attached.

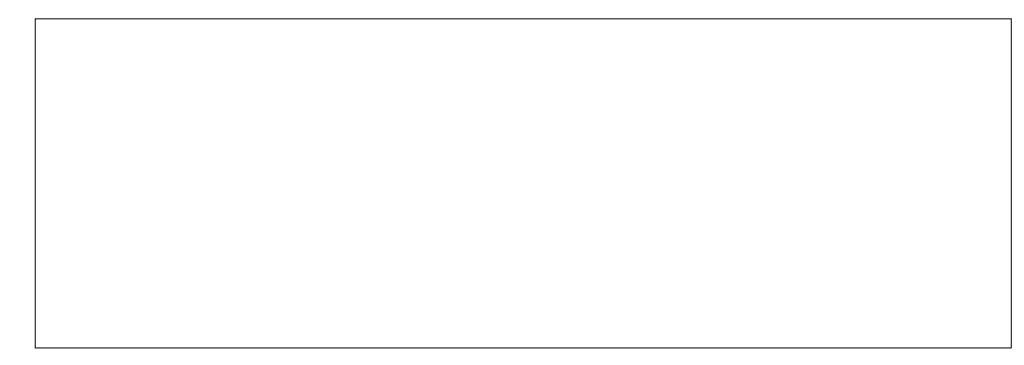

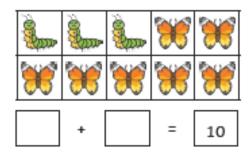
Number Bonds to 10 Ten-Frame Activity

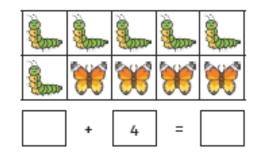


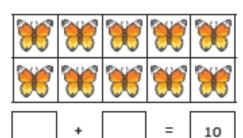


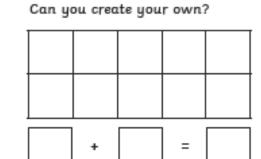
