WHAT BRENTSIDE DOES WELL

From the survey the 5 areas that Brentside performs the best in are

1)	My child feels safe at this school?	99% agree or strongly agree
2)	My child makes good progress at this school?	99% agree or strongly agree
3)	My child is happy at this school?	98% agree or strongly agree
4)	My child is taught well at this school?	98% agree or strongly agree
5)	This school is well led and managed?	96% agree or strongly agree

The comments written on the surveys were collated and the 5 main areas that parents believe Brentside Primary do well in are:-

- 1) The school provides good standards of teaching & Education
- 2) The school provides good homework and encouragement of home reading
- 3) The school has amazing teachers and staff
- The school keeps my children safe
- 5) There is good communication with parents through texts and calls

AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT AT BRENTSIDE

From the survey the 4 areas were shown as areas Brentside did not perform as well in

1)	This school responds well to any concerns I raise?	17% disagree or strongly disagree
2)	This school deals effectively with bullying?	13% disagree or strongly disagree
3)	My child receives appropriate homework for their age?	11% disagree or strongly disagree
4)	I receive valuable information about my child's progress?	8% disagree or strongly disagree

The 3 main areas for improvement from parental comments were identified as:-

- 1) A after school club and breakfast club is needed all year round for all year groups
- 2) More parental involvement and interaction is required
- More extra curriculum activities are needed including more sports clubs and matches

The school needs to cater more for working parents like children related activity after school clubs Involving the parents more and having more of a community within the school.
