## Effect of the PE & Sports Grant on participation and attainment & sustainability

- Continuation of Playground zones to encourage games and activities during play time, additional resources purchased
- Introduction of Rugby & Reading provided by local rubgy club Ealing Trailfinders.

  A coach from Trailfinders came weekly to the school and read one on one with pupils, then provided a rugby coaching session with the pupils.

#### **Effect of COVID 19**

- Planned sporting workshops were cancelled
- Our annual sports days were cancelled
- Summer Term swimming lessons for Year 4 were cancelled
- Our annual school dance afternoon competition was cancelled

Moving forward, for the Autumn Term of 2020-21 the school will not be taking Year 4 pupils for swimming lessons. We have undertaken a Risk Assessment and are currently, the risk levels to both pupils and adults is too high to go ahead with swimming lessons in the Autumn Term. This will be reviewed for the Spring Term.

We will review the COVID19 situation throughout the year and assess what sporting events and activities are safe to undertake.

### Sustainability

Moving forward we have entered into the School Sports Partnership which is run by Willow Tree Primary School. We have signed up the Gold level which provides us with the following:-

- Access to all school sports competitions and physical activity festivals
- Developing the role of the PE Subject Leader in line with curriculum development and OFSTED
- Delivery of 30 hours in school support from a qualified PE teacher.
- Facilitation of localised competitions and festivals and small cluster groups
- Member school of the FA Girls Football School Partnership programme
- 2 inclusive CPD sessions for school staff
- Access to free loan of school sporting equipment
- Links to community sports clubs
- Support to complete an application for School Games mark

Next academic year we are also planning on introducing the Daily Mile to encourage participation and increase the health and fitness levels of our pupils.
