Recent Initiatives / Improvements:

Part of the Pupil Premium allocation has gone towards whole school improvements, which include some of the initiatives listed below:-

- This year saw the introduction of music tuition on keyboard and guitar for all children in year 4
 and year .The academy purchased keyboards and guitars for children to use at home for the
 duration of the academic year to enable them to practice what they learnt in their lesson.
- Play therapist to help children with social, emotional and behavioural issues.
- The academy also increased the use of the Speech and Language Therapist within the school.
- A specialist sport teacher has been employed 3 days per week to utilise the Sports Grant provided by the government. The additional time is funded through pupil premium.
- Additional Numicon to support children's understanding in maths, especially in relation to number and calculation
- Reception play equipment to provide a fun and safe play environment for all Reception children
- Nursery & Reception Gardens- to allow children to learn about growing plants and vegetables
