- Phase 5 – blend phonemes to read CCVC and CVCC words and segment CCVC and CVCC words for spelling.
- Read and write sentences using phase 5 sounds.
- Read real and non-words in preparation for phonics screening.

Compose sentences orally before writing.
Using -ing, -ed, -er, -est where no changes are needed in the spelling of root words.
Spell days of the week.
Learn to appreciate and write rhymes and poems
Understand which letters belong to which handwriting families.
