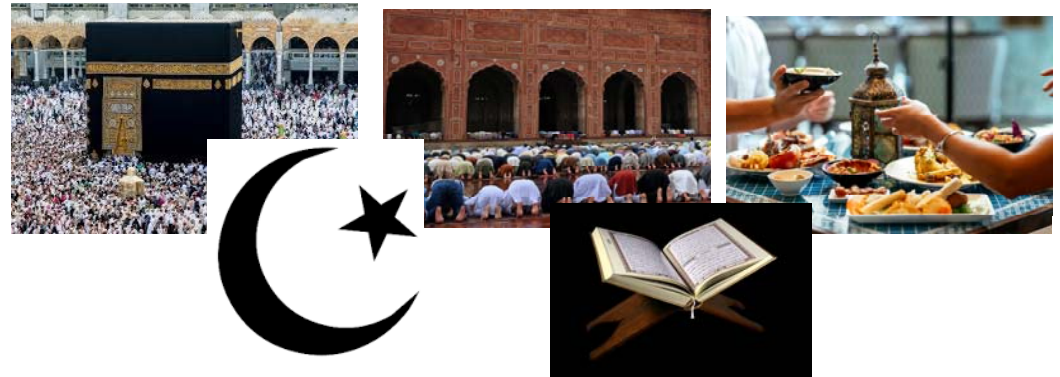

Vocabulary

Islam	The religion followed by Muslims.
Five pillars	The five bases of Islam.
Salat	Is the second pillar of Islam and is the Arabic word for prayer.
Sawm/fasting	Not eating or drinking for religious reasons. In Islam this is usually in the holy month of Ramadan and is the third pillar of Islam.
Zakkah	To give charity.
Hajj	A special pilgrimage carried out to Mecca by Muslims. Also a pillar of Islam.
Peace	A state of tranquillity
