I understand that there was a race to space and that Neil Armstrong was the first man to walk on the moon.

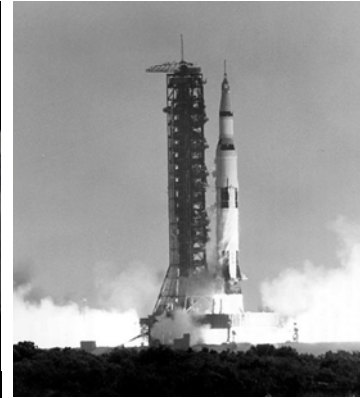
I understand that Amelia Earhart was the first women to complete a solo trip around the Atlantic sea.
