Vocabulary

Stencil	A template that is created so that the same design can be copied several times
Print	When paint is applied to a stencil and pushed down on pa- per to create a pattern
Wallpaper	A repeating pattern that is completed on paper and stuck to the walls
Styrofoam	A hard foam that can be cut into to make a stencil
Pattern	A design that is arranged in a particular way intentionally
Repeated pattern	A pattern that repeats several times to create a larger design
