### Vocabulary

Collage	Art in which bits and pieces of paper and fabric have been pasted onto a 2 dimensional surface.
Cut	The shape of a person, object etc. that has been cut out .
Mosaic	Pictures and patterns made from tiny pieces of coloured stone .
Montage	A group of images that relate to each other in some way to create a single work or part of a work of art .
Overlap	The placement of objects over one another.
