ENGLISH

Quality texts:

Wreck of the Zanzibar, Poetry – In the land of the Giants, The Nowhere Emporium, A Boy called Christmas.

Reading:

- -Know securely the different pronunciations of words with the same letter-string.
- Be familiar with some of the text types specified in the Year 5-6 programme of study.
- -Provide straightforward explanations for the purpose of the language, structure and presentation of texts e.g. bullet points; how a letter is set out; introductory paragraphs.
- -Discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language (e.g. simile, imagery) and its effect on the reader
- -Determine the meaning of new words by applying morphological knowledge of root words and affixes
- -Participate in discussion about texts, expressing and justifying opinions
- -Summarise main ideas from more than one paragraph, identifying key details which support these

Writing:

- -Spell some homophones from the Year 5-6 spelling appendix.
- -Describe characters, settings and plot, with growing precision.
- -Demarcate sentences correctly
- -Evaluate own and others' writing; with direction, proof read, edit and revise.
- -Use a dictionary and thesaurus to check the meaning of words and expand vocabulary.
- -Write to suit purpose and with a growing awareness of audience, using appropriate features.
- -Choose vocabulary and grammar to suit formal and informal writing, with guidance.

Grammar:

Use comma for a pause in complex sentences. Begin to use punctuation for parenthesis: brackets, commas, dashes
