ENGLISH

Quality texts:

Journey to Jo'burg, Boy: Tales of Childhood, Abomination, Poetry- Quick, Let's Get Out of Here!

Reading:

- Use appropriate intonation, tone and volume when reciting or reading aloud to an audience, to make the meaning clear.
- Fluently and automatically read a range of age-appropriate texts from the following: modern fiction and those from our literary heritage; books from other cultures; myths, legends and traditional stories; poetry; plays; non-fiction and reference or text books
- Distinguish fact from opinion with some success
- Draw inferences and justify these with evidence from the text
- Discuss their understanding of the meaning of challenging vocabulary in context

Writing:

- Spell some common homophones from the KS2 spelling appendix.
- Think about the effect of vocabulary choices.
- Discuss and develop initial ideas in order to plan and draft before writing.
- Use a range of presentational devices, including use of title, subheadings and bullet points.
- Use dialogue effectively to develop character and event. Achieve balance between dialogue and narrative writing

Grammar:

A range of punctuation is used, mostly accurately, including commas after fronted adverbials, possessive apostrophe for plural nouns and other punctuation to indicate direct speech
