
## **Key Questions:**

Vocabulary	
Running stitch	A style of sewing that uses <b>stitches</b> that look like a series of short lines with small spaces in between.
Backstitch	A stitch sewn one stitch length backward on the front side and two stitch lengths forward on the reverse side to form a solid line of stitching on both sides.
Cross stitch	A decorative style of sewing that uses stitches that cross each other to form an X.
Embroidery	The activity of decorating a piece of cloth with <b>stitches</b> se wn onto it.
Appliqué	Ornamental needlework in which pieces of fabric are sewn or stuck onto a large piece of fabric to form pictures or patterns.
