

Vocabulary	
Parables	The Holy stories told by Jesus and the disciples, these were short stories containing a moral message
resurrection	The rising of Jesus from the dead on Easter Sunday
incarnation	Jesus embodied in the flesh of God the father
transfiguration	A change of form or appearance
Lent	This is a period of 40 days leading up to Easter, the most significant festival for Christians.
Disciples/ apostles	The first followers of Jesus who helped to spread his important message
