

Year 6 Curriculum Information Sheet - Summer term



ENGLISH

Texts to be read: Romeo and Juliet by William Shakespeare, Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo, Thief by Malorie Blackman and Night of the Gargoyles by Eve Bunting

READING

Reading a range of genres from different times and cultures, being able to explain the genre specific language used in different text types. Children will develop a more mature understanding of the themes used in novels and will be able to persuade others to read texts based on their recommendations.

WRITING

Writing for different audiences and purposes, adapting writing styles. Using and linking paragraphs more consistently and using figurative language, imitating the style of writing from different authors.

SPELLING

Following the recommended spelling list for Year 6, reviewing spelling patterns from previous years, using dictionaries effectively.

GRAMMAR

Being able to apply all the grammatical rules to their own writing and explain why they have done so.

MATHS

NUMBER

Relating knowledge of number and place value to complex problem solving, describing probability using fractions and percentages. Ensuring a strong understanding of how to employ mental strategies to solve problems. Recapping the use of algebraic expressions.

SHAPE

Finding the area of a circle using the different strategies including the introduction of pie. Relating solid shapes to their nets and identifying the symmetrical properties of regular and irregular shapes.

MEASUREMENT

Converting between different units of measure – length, mass, volume and time Solving real life problems based on this knowledge.

The children will also be working through the Year 6/7 transition units outlined by the borough.
