Printing	An impression made by any method involving a transfer from one surface to another.
Polystyrene	Synthetic material used for printing as it is easy to mould.
Impression	Movement or transfer using a range of materials .
Printing board	A resource we will use to transfer paint from one surface to another.
Transfer	The movement of a substance.
Surface	Exploring surfaces how will the texture of a surface impact how a material is transferred..
Refine	To improve something through small changes that make it more effective or more subtle.
