Vocabulary

Seven wonders of the world	Impressive monuments created in the ancient world that were regarded with awe
Memorial	Service or statue dedicated to someone who died. A memorial service celebrates the life of the deceased.
Monument	an important site that is marked and preserved as public property to commemorate a person or event
Continent	Any of the seven large continuous land masses that constitute most of the dry land on the surface of the Earth.
Climate zones	The average weather or the regular variations in weather in a region over a period of years
Longitude	The angular distance east or west of the prime meridian that stretches from the North Pole to the South Pole and passes through Greenwich, England. Longitude is measured in degrees, minutes, and seconds.
Latitude	An imaginary line joining points on Earth's surface that are all of equal distance north or south of the equator
Conservation	The preservation, management, and care of natural and cultural resources
Pollution	The presence in or introduction into the environment of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects.
