## MRS CROSDALE'S GARDENING CLUB

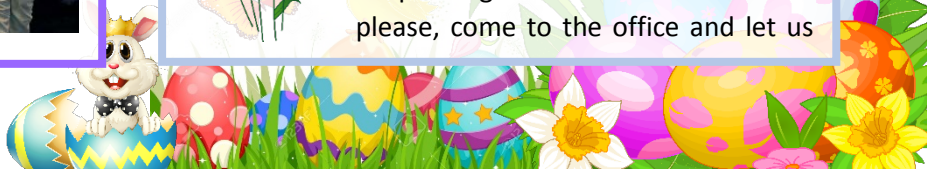

# OUR VALUES & CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

Over the next few weeks, we will be explaining how our school values link to Children's Rights

## Value: Creativity

**Links to Rights:** Article 13, Article 29, Article 31



We began by thinking about our school value **Creative** and how it connects to children's rights.

Every child has the right to express their ideas and creativity.

This right comes from the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Three important rights today are:

- **Article 13** – Every child has the right to share their thoughts and ideas.
- **Article 29** – Every child has the right to develop their talents
- **Article 31** – Every child has the right to play and be creative

When we encourage creativity, we are respecting children's rights.

Everyone deserves the chance to share ideas and discover their talents.
