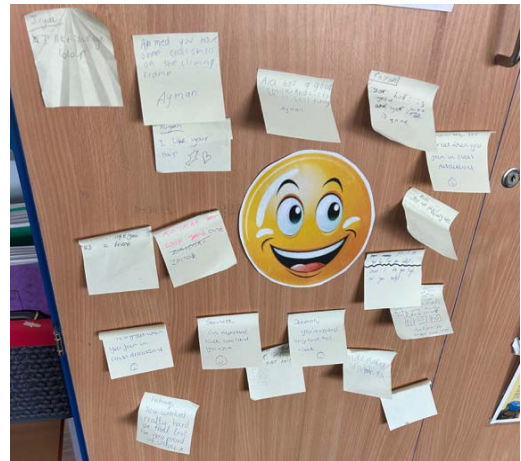
### CAKE SALE
