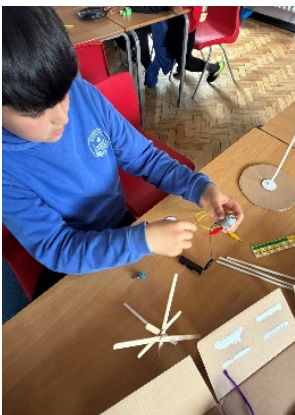
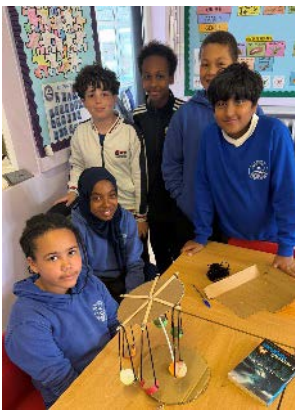


# YEAR 6 DT PROJECTS- FAIRGROUND RIDES

Each child confidently ordered their favourite ice cream in Spanish, showcasing everything they've learned in our unit.

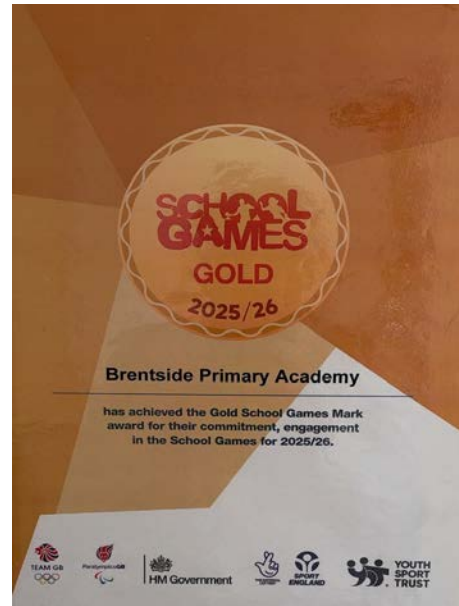
The smiles on their faces and the delicious treats made for a perfect end-of-unit celebration. I am so proud of their enthusiasm and progress!
